### ACT PREP CLASS – October 13 and March 22 (tentative)

### PSAT – October 11 (during the school day)

The PSAT is the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test. It measures verbal and math reasoning abilities important for doing college work and helps students improve their test-taking strategies before taking the SAT. This test is used to determine eligibility for the National Merit Scholarship program. You MUST sign up in the counseling office to take this test. This is a junior level test.

# FINANCIAL AID WORKSHOP - Date TBD

The Financial Aid Workshop will be held in the Commons at Boonville High School. A financial aid advisor will explain the types of aid and the process of applying for financial aid.

#### FAFSA FRENZY - Date TBD

Seniors can complete the online Free Application for Financial Aid with assistance from college financial aid advisors. FAFSA will not open until December 2023.

### ARMED SERVICES VOCATIONAL APTITUDE BATTERY (ASVAB) – November 17

The ASVAB will be given to all sophomores, juniors, and seniors who are interested in the military after graduation. Used for career information and shows aptitude in areas of math, science, English, mechanics, and shop.

# ACCUPLACER – January 9; also given at State Fair Community College on the Sedalia and Boonville Campuses

The Accuplacer is a computerized test that helps your college evaluate your skills and place you into appropriate courses. Accuplacer tests students in math, reading, and writing. You will receive your score immediately upon completion of testing. The Accuplacer will be given to ALL Juniors in January.
